### Neighborhood News

#### COUNCIL UPDATE:

- On Thursday March 9th, the council met in regular session. The Mayor presented Micah Pazoureck with an award for her many positive contributions to the Town. There were 16 items on the agenda which obviously cannot be covered in detail in our Newsletter. The following is a summary of the issues.

- Public Comments included concerns from several citizens regarding the enforcement of the “weed” Ordinance #00-04A. A revised ordinance will be presented to Council at the next meeting. The Council agreed no action was necessary concerning the Citizens petition regarding Ordinance #02-00A regarding front facing garages since both parties have revised their building plans in conformance with the ordinance. Council approved Ordinance #06-01 regarding Animal Control. Council tabled amendment to Ordinance #98-03 regarding Town Hall rental pending Council Loudens’ submittal of a revision for council consideration. Remaining items involved discussions of various issues which are available in the official minutes of the meeting.

- On Thursday, March 23rd, Council Linda Loudens submitted her resignation as council member Place #4 stating that she could not, in good conscience, continue to serve in the office for which she was elected. Ms. Loudens’ withdrawal was two days late for the May elections in the only contested place on the ballot. Therefore, the Town will have to conduct an election.

- On Sunday, March 26th the council conducted an emergency meeting. The Council accepted the resignation of Council Linda Loudens. The Council discussed the fact that Ms. Loudens’ resignation required the Council to appoint a replacement to ensure a quorum for future meetings. Given the fact that

On a rainy Saturday, February 25th, the Town had a record turnout for registration and vaccination of our “animal citizens”. We registered & photographed over 56 precious friends. During the March council meeting, the Council approved Ordinance #06-01 regarding Animal Control. Basically the ordinance requires a one time registration with the Town, at a cost of \$5.00, and requires the owners to provide a photo of their pet, up-to-date vaccination records, and the responsibility to provide the Town with updated information in the future. The Ordinance further addresses our responsibility to comply with our leash laws and penalties for failure to do so. The ordinance is available at Town Hall for review and all pet owners are encourage to make themselves familiar with the terms of the ordinance for the benefit of all.

- The next Regular Council meeting is scheduled for April 13th at 7:00 p.m. As always, the Council encourages all citizens to attend if their schedules allow. ☺

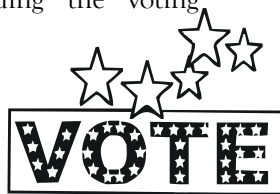
## MAY ELECTIONS

Town Council elections will be held for the following Council positions, at large, for two year terms.

- Council Place #2**, Gary Newsome Unopposed Appointed Incumbent replacing resigned Council Lynda Dean
- Council Place #4**, Contested by Ken Guthrie appointed incumbent replacing resigned Council Linda Louden. Opposing candidate is Linda Louden.
- Council Place #6**, Paul Bowers Unopposed Appointed Incumbent replacing resigned Mayor Frank Jaromin

Due to the fact that Acting Mayor Paul Bowers is unopposed, there will be an open seat for Council Place #3, for a term ending in May 2007. Citizens interested in being appointed to this position should contact the Town Secretary.
