

**Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation  
Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)  
MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The **Rocky Point** water system PWS ID **0610070** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period: **10/1/2025 – 12/31/2025**

The following actions have been taken to address this issue:

**The missed quarterly operating report has now been submitted to the TCEQ. The reporting lapse resulted from miscommunication during staff cross-training intended to provide additional coverage of duties. This violation was solely for failure to submit the required report on time. There was no issue with water quality.**
